## New Rockland location increases access to care



As the Reading Eagle stated, we took a "Giant" leap forward with our new location at Rockland Street. As a non-profit organization, such a leap can not go without a thorough market analysis that shows a tremendous need exists for a center in that area or without some funding that helps defray some of the start up costs.

The need assessment was clear. The 19604 and 19605 area was underserved medically and with transportation being such a barrier for many of our patients, an additional location in that area would be a sound decision. In addition, our 838 Penn Street location was near capacity and over 2,400 patients were coming from the proposed area. Finally, Patients were on a 6 month waiting list to access our dental services at 838 Penn Street.

The decision was easy. Our community needed an additional Community Health Center location that included expanding our dental capacity. But as a non-profit, we can't do that alone. Thanks to our state government, we received \$500,000 RACP (Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program) funding for the project. We also received funding from HRSA (Health Resources & Services Administration) to equip the Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) area and from Berks County Community Foundation to fund part of the Dental Suite. Because this is a multi-million dollar project, we continue to seek funding from additional sources.

We couldn't do it without the support we receive from our community too. Your continued support is very much appreciated. Thank you for helping us provide health care services to the underserved. We're in it together.
